Green Award 2017 for Colleges / Universities / Centre of Excellences in Tamilnadu

TNPCB vide this notification, calls for proposal from the Colleges / Universities / Centre of Excellences in Tamilnadu for **Green Award 2017**. This award will be given in recognition of the excellent contribution towards Protection of Environment by the Institution during the FY 2016-17.

The Application format is given below. The Last date for submission of proposal seeking the Green Award is 31st December 2017. The proposal shall be submitted to The Member Secretary, Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board, 76, Mount Salai, Guindy, Chennai – 600 032, through respective District Environmental Engineer, TNPCB.

The Proposal shall be prepared under the following headings

1. (a). Authority (Central / State) from which Recognition obtained with validity, and status of adopting Government norms.
(b). Protected water supply, Sanitation facilities provided to meet the requirement, back-up for power supply, first aid, housekeeping maintenance.
(c). Infrastructure facilities like Library, Play Grounds, Laboratories etc.,
2. (a) Green Belt Development – (Including No. of trees planted inside/outside of the premises with yearly increase data and survival rate).
(b). Rain Water Harvesting Facilities (Including No. of rain water harvesting facilities, size and capacity details to be furnished).
3. Water Conservation measures and Wastewater Management. (Including water audit, details on Sewage Treatment Plant, its performance, recycling of treated sewage etc)
4. (a) Energy conservation measures (Including energy audit, Solar power, wind energy utilization, reduction in the use of non renewable energy sources like use of petrol, diesel, electricity etc.,).

- (b) Green building concept initiatives.
5. Solid Waste Management Practices (Including details on management and scientific disposal of Solid Waste, Hazardous wastes, E-Waste, Bio-medical waste, Plastic Waste and Construction and Demolition Waste as per the Waste Management Rules 2016, Food waste management, Waste audit etc).
 6. Any new technology evolved by the students as part of their research programme which will result in environmental protection, better utilization of resources, alternative / renewable energy utilization, waste minimization, reduced emission levels etc.,
 7. Adopting villages and implementation of environmental protection activities (Other than activities carried out through National Service Scheme)
 8. Environmental Awareness Programme (Details on programme conducted within and outside the college campus etc.)
 9. Green Policy, Environmental Policy, ISO 14000 Certification etc., Yearly budget allotted for developing and maintenance for the environmental protection.
 10. Any other initiatives if any, in the field of environmental protection (including organizing intercollegiate seminars/conferences, conducting environmental exhibitions to create awareness etc.,)
