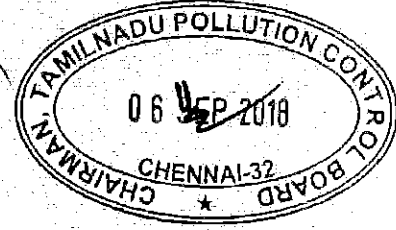

**ORDER :**

In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued according administrative sanction for implementation of Eco-restoration of Paruthipattu Lake in Avadi near Greater Chennai during the year 2016-17 and 2017-18 at a total cost of Rs.28.16 Crore (Rupees Twenty Eight crore and sixteen lakhs only) by availing the funds of Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board. Accordingly, the Government directed the Chairman, Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board to release a sum of Rs.7.16 Crore (Rupees Seven crore and sixteen lakhs only) during the year 2016-17 to the Director of Environment from the funds of Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board for implementation of the above work.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Environment / Member Secretary, Environment Management Agency of Tamil Nadu, Chennai has informed that a sum of Rs.7.16 Crore has already been released and the Phase I works have been completed by the Public Works Department. Further, it has also been informed that more than 50% of the works were completed under Phase II as per Government order first read above in anticipation of release of funds from Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board and necessary speedy action is also being taken to complete the rest of the project. Hence, the Director of Environment has requested to issue suitable orders immediately to release

Rs. 21.00 Crore from the Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board funds to the Director of Environment as per Government order for completing the works as well as settlement of bills for the completed works by the Public Works Department.

3. The Government after careful examination, direct the Chairman, Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board to release a sum of Rs.21.00 Crore (Rupees Twenty one crore only) to the Director of Environment from the funds of Tamil Nadu Pollution Control Board for implementation of the Eco-restoration (Phase II) in paruthipattu lake in Avadi as per the details annexed to this order.

4. The Director of Environment is also requested to ensure that proper mechanism is put in place to avoid further pollution after the eco-restoration works are completed.

5. Further, the Director of Environment is authorized to release the fund to the Executive Engineer, Public Works Department / Water Resource Development, Kosasthalaiyar Basin Division, Thiruvallur.
